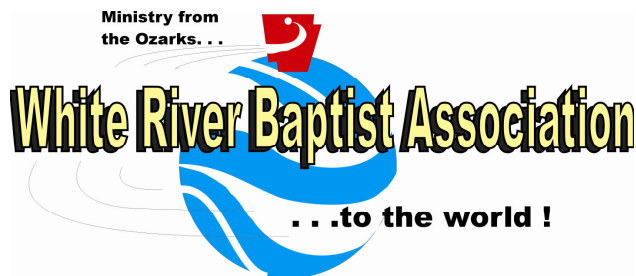

2007 Associational Missions Week PRAYER GUIDE

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 1:8 NIV

The Baptist Association is a partnership of local Southern Baptist churches developing and implementing cooperative Acts 1:8 strategies, which has been going on for 300 years in America and since 1840 in White River Baptist Association. White River Association is one of the oldest associations in Arkansas, coming into existence 4 years after Arkansas became a state and 5 years before the organization of the Southern Baptist Convention and 8 years before the Arkansas Baptist State Convention became a reality.

It is the desire of the association, which is comprised of 28 churches in Marion and Baxter Counties, to share the story of God's redeeming love both locally and globally. During the Associational Missions Week, make the Acts 1:8 challenge an important part of your prayer life.

- Use this prayer guide as you pray for your Baptist Association of churches.
- Share your story about Jesus' redeeming love with someone this week.
- Find out how you can serve as a missions volunteer in your church or association.

Sunday, Day 1 Jerusalem Revival

"Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land. " 2 Chron.7:14 NLT

- Pray that each Christian in the local churches will humbly pray and seek God.
- Pray God will reveal His will to us.
- Pray for a spiritual awakening in our communities and our nation.

Monday, Day 2 Jerusalem Compassion

"Seeing the people, He felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and dispirited like sheep without a shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest.'" Matt. 36-38 NASB

- Pray that the local church members will see the people of our Jerusalem with eyes of compassion.
- Pray that the compassion of church members will move them to witness to others.
- Pray the Lord of the Harvest will send workers into the Jerusalem field.

Tuesday, Day 3 Judea Missions Ministries

"The church in Judea ... now had a time of peace and kept on worshipping the Lord. The church became stronger, as the Holy Spirit encouraged it and helped it grow." Acts 9:31 CEV

- Pray for the efforts to minister to the growing numbers of Hispanics living in our area.
- Pray for the strengthening of the disaster relief and construction teams by bringing more volunteers into the ministries.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will open the eyes of key churches to have a heart for starting additional churches as He directs.
- Pray for the Pam Rosinbaum and the Baptist Student Ministries at ASU Mountain Home; that they will be successful in reaching out to college students enrolled at ASU.

Wednesday, Day 4 Judea Church Development –Family Ministry

"Then Paul spoke the Word of God to him and his family. ..He and all his family were full of joy for having put their trust in God." Acts 16:32, 34b NLT

- Pray for the Regional Summit on Reaching Senior Adults on September 8, 2007; that many local and surrounding churches will participate; that many Senior Adults will be reached for the glory of God.
- Pray for strengthening of every church in White River Baptist Association to reach the youth, children, single adults, senior adults, and families in our area.

Thursday, Day 5 Samaria Chaplaincy

Saturday, Day 7 To The Ends of the Earth
